Scholarship Rules and Regulations

The mission of the Mentor Area Chamber of Commerce Foundation Scholarship is to select students who have the desire to further their education beyond the high school level.

- A. The scholarship shall be known as the Don-Mar Krueger Scholarship.
- B. The scholarship is to be used for education beyond the high school level in any college, trade or technical school.
- C. The scholarship is open to any senior of a Mentor City school or student of a Mentor Area Chamber of Commerce member.
- D. There will be no restrictions as to race, color, creed, gender, religion or disability.
- E. A minimum of two post-secondary scholarships, in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded. Providing the necessary funds are available, other scholarship awards may be given as deemed appropriate by the Mentor Area Chamber of Commerce Education Committee with approval of the Foundation Board of Directors.
- F. In order to receive this award, the winner(s) must present a letter of acceptance by May 30 from a school/institution beyond the high school level.
- G. If, for any reason, the scholarship recipient is unable to use the scholarship during the ensuing school year, the student forfeits his/her right to the scholarship.
- H. The scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of desire, responsibility, academic achievement and financial need.
- I. The selection process will be made by the Education Committee based on the information submitted in this application.
- J. The information requested helps the Education Committee understand the applicant's qualifications. However, not all of the information is part of the criteria for awarding the scholarship. This should not preclude any student who wishes to further their education from participating.
- K. The application must be signed in order to be accepted.
- L. The application may be handwritten or typed.

The application Deadline is **2/24/2010 and must be submitted to the Mentor Area Chamber of Commerce office at 6972 Spinach Dr., Mentor, OH, 44060 prior to this date.**

Attachments Required With Scholarship Application

- A1. Write a 100 word essay on "What Do You See Yourself Doing In The Business Community In Five Years?"**
- A2. Supply one letter of recommendation from an individual, who is not a relative, attesting to character and service qualities.**
- A3. If you, or either parent, works for a company that is a Mentor Area Chamber of Commerce member, please supply a letter from that member company verifying employment.**
- A4. Transcript of most recent grades including class standing.**
- A5. The applicant may supply any additional information he/she wishes in support of the scholarship application.**
